Pike County Court Sentencing Information
Friday April 26, 2013

Pike County District Attorney Ray Tonkin announced the following criminal sentences were issued by Pike County President Judge Joseph F. Kameen:

Linda Lawlor, age 47, of Lakeville, PA was sentenced to the Intermediate Punishment Program for 5 years with 32 days of incarceration in the Pike County Correctional Facility, 90 days of house arrest, ordered to pay a fine of \$ 1,500.00 and had her driver's license suspended for 18 months for the crimes of Driving Under the Influence. On March 17, 2012 in Palmyra Township, Lawlor was found to be driving under the influence. Her blood alcohol level was .243%.

Stephanie Fleischer, age 27, of Bloomingburg, NY was sentenced to the Pike County Correctional Facility for 1 month and 21 days to 23 ½ months and ordered to pay a fine of \$ 300.00 for the crime of Criminal Conspiracy to Commit Retail Theft. On February 13, 2013, in Westfall Township, Fleischer agreed with two others to take two televisions from a retail store without paying the full retail value of \$ 2,139.00.

Gabriel Pavlogianis, age 22, of Dingmans Ferry, PA was sentenced to the Intermediate Punishment Program for 6 months with 10 days of incarceration in the Pike County Correctional Facility, 60 days of house arrest, ordered to pay a fine of \$ 750.00 for the crime of Driving Under the Influence. On December 22, 2012 in Blooming Grove Township, Pavlogianis was found to be driving under the influence. His blood alcohol level was .144%.

Edgardo Juarez-Velasquez, age 49, of Cockeysville, MD was sentenced to the Pike County Correctional Facility for 36 days to 12 months and ordered to pay a fine of \$ 200.00 for the crime of Retail Theft. On March 15, 2013, Juarez-Velasquez took an HP

Envy Touch Computer and a 32 inch Samsung Television without paying the full retail value of \$ 1,086.00.

Pike County District Attorney Ray Tonkin announced the following criminal sentences were issued by Pike County President Judge Joseph F. Kameen:

Donald Beck, age 21, of Dingman Ferry, PA was sentenced to a State Correctional Facility for 1 to 3 years and ordered to pay a fine of \$ 300.00 for the crime of Burglary. On November 16, 2010, Beck entered a residence in Lehman Township and took various items valued in excess of \$ 2,000.00.

Tyreak Cowan, age 24, of Bushkill, PA was sentenced to the Pike County Correctional Facility for 2 to 18 months and ordered to pay a fine of \$ 300.00 for the crime of Receiving Stolen Property. On September 14, 2011, in Lehman Township, Cowan was found in possession of a 1985 class ring knowing it had been stolen.

Celeste Schafer, age 22, of Hawley, PA was sentenced to the Pike County Correctional Facility for 3 to 23 ½ months, ordered to pay a fine of \$ 600.00 and restitution of over \$ 11,000.00 for the crime of Receiving Stolen Property. In February 2012, Schafer was in possession of various assorted pieces of jewelry, a fire safe, silver certificates, baseball cards and miscellaneous paperwork, knowing these items had been stolen. In a separate incident between May and June 2012, Schafer was in possession of Bulova Watch, an Xbox 360 and an Apple I-Phone knowing these items had been stolen.

Murat Patirdi, age 28, of Dingmans Ferry, was sentenced to the Pike County Correctional Facility for 1 to 5 years, ordered to pay a fine of \$ 1,725.00 and had his driver's license suspended for 18 months for the crime of Driving Under the Influence and two motor vehicle code violations. On November 27, 2011 in Lehman Township, Patirdi was found to be driving under the influence of cocaine and without a valid driver's license.
