HONESDALE, PA - JANUARY 10, 2013

The following cases were addressed by the Honorable Kenneth W. Seamens, Specially Presiding, Wayne County:

CHLOE MARIE CEREP, age 19 of Moscow, PA was placed on the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program for a period of 12 months related to Possession of a Controlled Substance. She was ordered to pay all Court costs and perform 30 hours of community service. The incident occurred on June 24, 2012, in Waymart Borough when Waymart Borough Police discovered Cerep to be in possession of Marijuana.

MICHAEL CHRISTOPHER NOVAK, age 22 of Forest City, PA was placed on the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program for a period of 12 months related to Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. He was ordered to pay all Court costs and perform 30 hours of community service. The incident occurred on July 5, 2012, in Waymart Borough when Waymart Borough Police discovered Novak to be in possession of Marijuana paraphernalia.

ANDREW PAUL SWINGLE, age 22 of Honesdale, PA was placed on the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program for a period of 6 months related to Unauthorized Use of Automobiles. He was ordered to pay all Court costs and perform 30 hours of community service. The incident occurred on July 27, 2012, in Lebanon Township when Swingle used a vehicle belonging to another knowing that he did not have permission to do so.

JASON RICHARD DOHERTY, age 37 of Honesdale, PA was placed on the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program for a period of 6 months related to DUI. He was also ordered to pay all Court costs, perform 30 hours of community service, have his operator's license suspended for a period of 60 days, and attend and complete an alcohol highway safety program. The incident occurred on August 18, 2012, in Cherry Ridge Township when Pennsylvania State Police were called to investigate the report of a one vehicle crash. His BAC was .262%.

MEGAN ERIN MCHALE, age 20 of Lakeville, PA pled guilty, in two separate cases, to one count of Tampering With or Fabricating Physical Evidence, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 2nd Degree and one count of Theft By Deception-False Impression, also graded as a Misdemeanor of the 2nd Degree. The incident occurred on August 9, 2010, in Preston Township when Midolo cashed a check she had stolen from a private residence. She is scheduled to be sentenced on March 7, 2013.

SHAWN MICHAEL HARLOS, age 29 of Honesdale, PA pled guilty to one count of Delivery of Controlled Substance, an ungraded Felony. The incident occurred on April 24, 2012, in Texas Township when Harlos sold Cocaine to a confidential informant. He is scheduled to be sentenced on March 28, 2013.

JASON SCOTT KENYON, age 27 of Honesdale, PA pled guilty to one count of Delivery of Controlled Substance, an ungraded Felony. The incident occurred on March 23, 2012, in Honesdale Borough when Kenyon sold Marijuana to a confidential informant. He is scheduled to be sentenced on March 28, 2013.

JAMES C. HOUSE, age 44 of Honesdale, PA pled guilty to one count of Theft By Deception-False Impression, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 1st Degree. The incident occurred on December 29, 2011, in Hawley Borough when House received monies for home improvement services which he failed to provide. He is scheduled to be sentenced on March 7, 2013.

ALEX TIMOTHY COE, age 19 of Lake Ariel, PA pled guilty to one count of Possession of Controlled Substance, an ungraded Misdemeanor. The incident occurred on April, 23, 2012, in Paupack Township when Coe was discovered to be in possession of Marijuana. He is scheduled to be sentenced on March 7, 2013.

The following cases were addressed by the Raymond L. Hamill, President Judge, Wayne County:

HONESDALE, PA - JANUARY 16, 2013

DANIEL LAHOTSKI, age 30 of Throop, PA was sentenced to the Wayne County Correctional Facility for a period of not less than 4 months nor more than 5 years for one count of Driving Under Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance, an ungraded Misdemeanor and one count of DUI-Highest Rate, also an ungraded Misdemeanor. He was also ordered to pay all Court costs, pay a fine in the amount of \$1,500.00, undergo a drug and alcohol evaluation and comply with all recommendations for treatment, attend and complete an alcohol highway safety program, obtain full time employment upon being released from prison and perform 100 hours of community service. The incident occurred on September 18, 2010, in Canaan Township. His BAC was .291%.

DANIEL HUTCHINS, age 51 of Damascus, PA was sentenced to the Wayne County Correctional Facility for a period of not less than 90 days nor more than 6 months for one count of DUI-Highest Rate, an ungraded Misdemeanor and one count of Driving While Operating Privilege Suspend/Revoked, graded as a Summary offense. He was also ordered to pay all Court costs, pay a fine in the amount of \$2,000.00, pay restitution in the amount of \$1,901.38, undergo a drug and alcohol evaluation together with a mental health evaluation and comply with all recommendations for treatment, attend and complete an alcohol highway safety program and obtain full time employment upon being released from prison. The incident occurred on June 29, 2012, in Honesdale Borough when Honesdale Borough Police were called to investigate the report of a one vehicle crash. His BAC was .233%.

He was ordered to pay all Court costs, perform 40 hours of community service, attend and complete an alcohol highway safety program, and have his operator's license suspended for a period of 60 days. The incident occurred on October 7, 2012, in Damascus Township when Pennsylvania state Police were called to investigate the report of a one vehicle crash. His BAC was .164%.

She was ordered to pay all Court costs, perform 40 hours of community service, attend and complete an alcohol highway safety program, and have her operator's license suspended for a period of 60 days. TYLER COLE SPENCER, age 18 of Honesdale, PA pled guilty to one count of Ethnic Intimidation, graded as a Felony of the 3rd Degree, three counts of Terroristic Threats-Cause Serious Public Inconvenience, graded as a Misdemeanors of the 1st Degree, one count of Criminal Conspiracy-Simple Assault, graded as Misdemeanor of the 2nd Degree, one count of Recklessly Endangering Another Person , graded as a Misdemeanor of the 2nd Degree, and one count of Careless Driving, graded as a Summary offense. The first incident occurred between July 13, 2012, and July 16, 2012, in Clinton and Canaan Townships when Trail and two co-defendants entered a local summer camp. The second incident occurred on July 16, 2012, in Honesdale Borough when Spencer hit a male victim with his truck causing injury. He is scheduled to be sentenced on April 11, 2013.

JEREMIAH THOMAS WAREHAM, age 29 of Pittsburgh, PA pled guilty, in two separate cases, to one count of Firearms Not to Be Carried Without License, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 1st Degree, one count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, an ungraded Misdemeanor, three counts of Luring a Child Into Motor Vehicle or Structure, graded as a Misdemeanors of the 1st Degree and one count of Open Lewdness, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 3rd Degree. The first incident occurred on May 27, 2012, in Texas Township and the second incident occurred on June 13, 2012, in Waymart Borough. He is scheduled to be sentenced on April 4, 2013.

JUSTIN DAVID SHOEMAKER, age 19 of Honesdale, PA pled guilty, in two separate cases, to one count of Retail Theft-Take Merchandise, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 2nd Degree and one count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, an ungraded Misdemeanor. The first incident occurred on June 30, 2012, in Texas Township when Shoemaker stole items from a local department store. The second incident occurred on September 29, 2012, in Honesdale Borough when Shoemaker was found to be in possession of Marijuana and Oxycodone. He is scheduled to be sentenced on April 11, 2013.

ANDREW DAVID DICKINSON, age 61 of Waymart, PA pled guilty to one count of Recklessly Endangering Another Person, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 2nd Degree and one count of Failure to Control or Report Dangerous Fires, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 1st Degree. The incident occurred on September 17, 2010, in Waymart Borough when Dickinson failed to report a building on fire. He is scheduled to be sentenced on April 4, 2013.

ANDREW C. RUSHIN, age 23 of Scranton, PA pled guilty, in two separate cases, to two counts of Theft By Unlawful Taking or Disposition, graded as a Misdemeanors of the 1st Degree. The first incident occurred on August 26, 2011, in Lehigh Township when Rushin stole copper and metal. The second incident occurred on March 25, 2012, in Lehigh Township when Rushin and two co-defendants stole a golf cart. He is scheduled to be sentenced on April 4, 2013.

WARREN NEIL PETERSEN, age 48 of Hawley, PA pled guilty to one count of Illegally Operate Vehicle Without Ignition Interlock, an ungraded Misdemeanor and one count of Drive Without Lights to Avoid Identification/Arrest, graded as a Summary offense. The incident occurred on August 18, 2011, in Hawely Borough when Hawley Borough Police observed Petersen traveling at a high rate of speed. He is scheduled to be sentenced on April 11, 2013.

RAYMOND MAURICE NEDAB, age 52 of Lake Ariel, PA pled guilty to one count of Criminal Conspiracy-Identity Theft, graded as a Felony of the 3rd Degree. The incident occurred on February 21, 2012, in Salem Township when Nedab conspired with another to use a stolen credit card. He is scheduled to be sentenced on April 4, 2013.

CECELIA ANN NEDAB, age 51 of Lake Ariel, PA pled guilty to one count of Identity Theft, graded as a Felony of the 3rd Degree. The incident occurred on February 21, 2012, in Palmyra Township when Nedab used a stolen credit card to obtain cash from an ATM machine. She is scheduled to be sentenced on April 4, 2013.

STEVEN ANTHONY PEREZ, age 21 of Greentown, PA pled guilty to one count of Harassment-Communicates Repeatedly, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 3rd Degree. The incident occurred on April 19, 2012, in Honesdale Borough. He is scheduled to be sentenced on March 28, 2013.

JOSHUA WENGLER, age 36 of Honesdale, PA pled guilty to one count of Simple Assault, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 3rd Degree. The incident occurred between June 1, 2011, and June 1, 2012, in Honesdale Borough when Wengler assaulted a female victim. He is scheduled to be sentenced on February 7, 2013.

JONATHAN ROBERT HARDMAN, age 32 of Hawley, PA pled guilty to one count of DUI-Highest Rate, an ungraded Misdemeanor and one count of Accident Involving Damage to Attended Veh/Property, graded as a Summary Offense. The incident occurred on June 29, 2012, in Hawley Borough. His BAC was .221%. He is scheduled to be sentenced on April 4, 2013.

STEPHEN CABLE, age 35 of Honesdale, PA pled guilty to one count of Harassment-Strike, Shove, Kick, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 3rd Degree. The incident occurred on August 28, 2012, in Honesdale Borough when Cable shoved a female victim. He is scheduled to be sentenced on April 4, 2013.

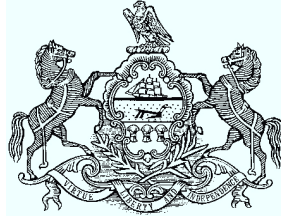

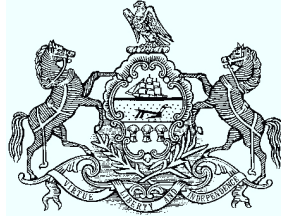

HONESDALE, PA - February 7, 2013

JOSEPH JOHN WILLIAMS, age 33 of Lake Ariel, PA was sentenced to the Wayne County Correctional Facility for a period of not less than 72 hours nor more than 6 months for one count of DUI-Highest Rate, an ungraded Misdemeanor. He was also ordered to pay all Court costs, pay a fine in the amount of \$1,000.00, undergo a drug and alcohol evaluation and comply with all recommendations for treatment, attend and complete an alcohol highway safety program, perform 50 hours of community service, and obtain full time employment upon being released from prison. The incident occurred on April 22, 2012, in Salem Township when Pennsylvania State Police were called to investigate the report of a one vehicle crash. His BAC was .402%.

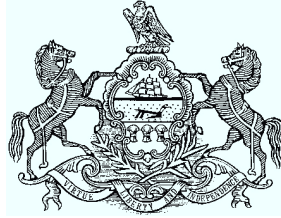

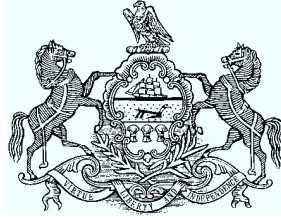

He was also ordered to pay all Court costs, and pay restitution in the amount of \$115,019.29. 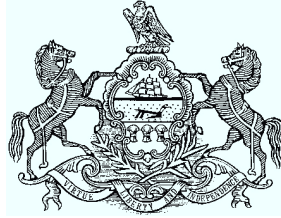

The following case was addressed by the Raymond L. Hamill, President Judge, Wayne County:

HONESDALE, PA - April 18, 2013

JAMES LEO BRENNAN, age 68 of Honesdale, PA was sentenced to the Wayne County Correctional Facility for a period of not less than 45 days followed by 60 months less 45 days in the Intermediate Punishment Program, for one count of DUI or Controlled Substance, graded as a Misdemeanor of the 1st Degree. He was also ordered to pay all Court costs, undergo house arrest with electronic monitoring for a period of 45 days, pay a fine in the amount of \$2,000.00, attend and complete an alcohol highway safety program and perform 100 hours of community service. The incident occurred on April 13, 2013, in Honesdale Borough when Honesdale Borough Police observed Brennan traveling at a high rate of speed. 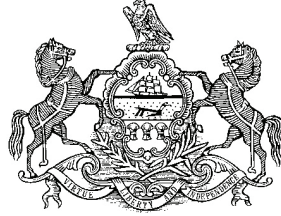
